THE CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

1st Timothy 3: 1-5. "But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers. Disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of Godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!" I think we all, either now or in the past, have fit some where in this. The only thing that can set us apart from this is salvation through Jesus Christ and then follow Him.

In the last Chaplain's Corner I said Delores and I would watch both Political Conventions and for the most part we did. The contrast could not have been greater. One convention closed out each night with prayer in the name of Jesus. The other, Jesus Christ was never mentioned. One spoke about foreign policy, closing the borders, getting elections on paper ballots, removing the Federal Department of Education, drilling for oil and much more. The other convention emphasized killing babies by abortion, mutilating children to change their sex, giving Medicare and Social-Security to undocumented aliens, lowering taxes, nothing about closing borders- just an ineffective bill that the other party would not support. Foreign policy was mentioned once by the candidate. who, by the way, is not constitutional, having not received one popular vote by the public to be the candidate for the president of the United States. I don't believe you will ever see a sharper contrast between two parties and between two candidates.

Jesus Christ shed His blood for the salvation of everyone in the world. Since that time hundreds of thousands of Christians have sacrificed themselves that others might know peace through surrendering themselves to Jesus.

There have been hundreds of thousand of people who have shed their blood and laid down their lives for this country. The saving of this country this time will come, first, by praying, second, by voting and making sure your vote gets counted.


